3D SHOOTOUT EVENT RULES

ALL COMPETITIVE SHOOTERS MUST BE REGISTERED BY 3:30PM ON THURSDAY, JULY 3, 2025

Held at Sunrise Park Resort, the 3D Shootout has been growing steadily for 38 years. This event is 3 days of challenging archery courses, live entertainment, and national vendors at a unique location. Prizes include the World-Renowned White Mountain Apache 2025 Trophy Elk Hunt (raffle exclusive to competitive shooters), trophies and many more prizes and raffles. Summer activities are in full swing at the resort with lift rides, a climbing wall, the tubing hill, drop zone, and much more. Don't forget we have lift rides, base activities, a light parade, and live music at Sunrise base area on Friday, July 4th, through 8:00pm.

COMPETITIVE SHOOT

The competition shoot will be a two-day tournament beginning on Friday, July 4, 2025 at 8:30am at the Base of Cyclone. It will continue the following day, July 5th, concluding with an award ceremony at the Base of Sunrise.

The 3D Archery Tournament will consist of four Competitive courses with 20 targets each. There will also be one Pee-Wee/Cub Competitive course with 10 targets, making a total of five courses for the Competition Shoot. Archers who wish to participate may pre-register online at www.sunrise.ski by Sunday, June 29, 2025. Competitive shooters registering after June 29th must do so on-site during normal operating hours (Wednesday or Thursday).

Rules and Scoring:

- A warm-up area will be provided.
- 3 ring scoring 8, 10, and 12. 5 points on the body - not including hoof, face, horns, or tail. There is no 14 point scoring ring - shots in the 14 ring will be counted as a body shot (5 points).
- There will be two score keepers on each target.
- Dividing lines are part of the higher scoring. The arrow shaft must only touch the dividing line between the scoring zones to score the higher value.
- Tie breaker will be determined by a 1 arrow shoot-off.
- If there is any question about an arrow the Field Captain/Field Judge will be called to determine the score.
- Once the scores are added and verified by the scorekeepers and the archer, the cards will be signed. Once the score cards are turned into registration the final score will not change! Check your own score and make sure it is correct.
- Each target can determine who shoots first. If any issues arise the Field Captain / Field Judge will decide on the order of shooters.
- This is not a timed event, however, if an archer or a target of archers who repeatedly take longer than 5/10 minutes the Field Captain / Field Judge can either speak to the individual archer or target to speed things up. The Field Captain / Field Judge can move an archer(s) to another target to keep the tournament flowing smoothly. (2 minutes time limit)
- During a round, no modifications or adjustments may be made to the bow and its related equipment unless equipment failure is recognized.
- No loser sites allowed.

NOTE: Any animal that is harmed or killed may result in disqualification and fine.

Equipment Failure: If you have equipment failure, notify the Field Captain / Field Judge right away. You will have 20 minutes to make repairs. The archer will make up any missed arrows at the end of the distance or at the end of the round.

Medical issues: In the event of a medical issue notify the Field Captain / Field Judge right away. The medical issue will be evaluated to determine whether the archer is able to continue to compete unassisted. If the archer is able to continue, he/she will be given 20 minutes to recover. The archer will make up any missed arrows at the end of the distance or at the end of the round.

Equipment:

Recurves

- Tabs or gloves ok
- Stabilizers ok
- Kisser buttons ok
- String must touch limbs
- No string peeps
- No magnification sights
- No release aid
- No levels

Compounds

- Bows with pullies, wheels/cams
- Release aid, any type of sign/scope
- Stabilizers under 18"

Longbows

- No carbon or ceramic bows
- String does not touch limb
- No string peeps
- Wood shaft arrows w/ feathers or plastic nocks are permitted
- Bowstring may be any material
- No stabilizers permitted
- No mechanical or solid release aid permitted

NON-COMPETITIVE SHOOT / SHOOT FOR FUN

The Shoot for Fun is a non-competitive shoot that consists of 12 Courses with 10-15 targets per course. The fun shoot will begin at 8:00am on Thursday, July 3, 2025 at the base of Sunrise; ending at 6:00pm on Saturday, July 5, 2025. Lift access is available from 9:00am to 4:00pm for shooters. Courses must be cleared by 6:00pm each day.

Shoot for Fun courses consist of the following:

- One Family Friendly Walking Course, nearest Sunrise Base - 10 Targets
- One Child Friendly Walking Course, nearest Sunrise Base - 10 Targets
- Two Lift Accessed, Extreme Courses (Ages 18+) - 10 Targets per course
- Four Lift Accessed, Fun Courses - 15 Targets per course
- Four Walking Fun Courses - 15 Targets per course

NOTE: Any animal that is harmed or killed may result in disqualification and fine.

- 30 yard max (yellow)
- Unknown yardage
- No range finder
- Recurve or longbow okay
- No compound bows

CUB MALE (CBM)

- Ages 9-12
- 25 yards max (white)
- No bow restrictions
- No sight restrictions
- No range finder

MALE BOWHUNTER RELEASE (MBR)

- 50 yards max (red)
- Fixed pins
- No range finder
- Release - finger release okay

FEMALE BOWHUNTER RELEASE (FBR)

- 40 yards max (pink)
- Fixed pin
- No range finder
- Release - finger release okay

CUB FEMALE (CBF)

- Ages 9-12
- 25 yards max (white)
- No bow restrictions
- No sight restrictions
- No range finder

MALE BOWHUNTER OPEN (MBO)

- 50 yards max (red)
- No range finder
- No bow restrictions
- Movable sights okay

FEMALE BOWHUNTER OPEN (FBO)

- 40 yards max (pink)
- No range finder
- No bow restrictions
- Movable sights okay

PEE-WEE (PW)

- Ages 8 and under
- 15 yards max (orange)
- No bow restrictions
- No sight restrictions
- Range finder okay

MALE KNOWN OPEN (MKO)

- 50 yards max (red)
- Range finder okay
- No bow restrictions
- Stabilizers okay

FEMALE KNOWN OPEN (FKO)

- 40 yards max (pink)
- Range finder okay
- No bow restrictions
- Stabilizers okay

MONEY SHOOT (MONEY)

- All ages
- 50 yards max (red)
- Winner takes 50% of all entry fees for Money Class
- No Rangefinder
- No bow restrictions
- No sight restrictions
- In the case of a tie, most bulls eyes win
- In the case of a bulls eye tie, one arrow shoot-off wins

MALE SENIOR (50-59) (MSN)

- 40 yards max (pink)
- No rangefinders
- No bow restrictions

FEMALE SENIOR (50-59) (FSN)

- 40 yards max (pink)
- No rangefinders
- No bow restrictions

MALE MASTERS (60+) (MMST)

- 40 yards max (pink)
- No range finder
- No bow or sight restrictions

FEMALE MASTERS (60+) (FMST)

- 40 yards max (pink)
- No range finder
- No bow or sight restrictions

YOUTH MALE (13-17) (YM)

- 30 yards max (yellow)
- No range finder
- No sight restrictions

YOUTH FEMALE (13-17) (YF)

- 30 yards max (yellow)
- No range finder
- No sight restrictions
